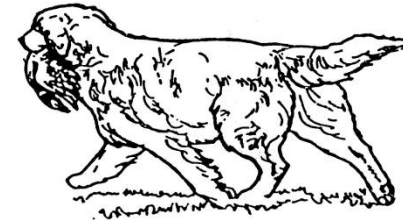

UDX CLASS

Dogs entered in the UDX class will be entered in both Open B and Utility B, and the combined fee for the two classes must be paid. Once the limit has been reached in either Open B or the Utility B class, the UDX class will be considered closed. Any subsequent entries for the class will be unacceptable in their entirety.

JUMP HEIGHT ORDER

Entries will be arranged in descending jump height order. Therefore, jump height is **required** on the entry form. We will attempt to contact you if your entry is missing this information. Failing that, we will place your dog based on its breed and a typical height for that breed. Please make our trial secretary's job easier and provide your jump height. We will make every effort to separate multiple dogs being shown by the same handler, even if it means putting one dog out of jump height order, but that will be the only exception to jump height order.

MOVE-UPS

Request for move-ups must be made in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next class level and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

NO SMOKING ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING

RALLY AND OBEDIENCE TRIAL AWARDS

NOTE TO EXHIBITORS

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Mail all entries with fees to Beth Meade, 1882 Ashley Drive, Ypsilanti, MI 48198. Entries received without fees with not be accepted. Entries sent overnight or express mail or other similar services should be designated "**NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED**".

Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical after closing date with judging program and directions to the trial site. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary.

Obedience entry fees include a \$0.50 AKC Recording Fee for every dog entered in the Obedience trial, and a \$3.00 AKC Event Services Fee for each Obedience class entered. Rally entry fees include a \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee for each Rally class entered.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show giving club will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Errors on entry forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

No practicing will be allowed in the rings at any time.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

Bitches in Season – A refund of all entry fees less \$10.00 will be made to any exhibitor who has a bitch entered who comes in season after the entries close. To be eligible for a refund, a statement from a veterinarian must be presented to the Trial Secretary no later than 9:00 AM the morning of the trial or the veterinarian's statement may be mailed to the Trial Secretary, provided it is received prior to the opening of the trial.

Multiple Entries – When there is a multiple entry of the same dog, only the highest score will be eligible for special awards.

RALLY TRIAL MOVE-UP FORM

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
